



2024 UAW Trust Vaccine Clinic: Trust Member FAQ.

Q: What vaccines are available at the clinic?

A: The clinic will offer the flu and COVID vaccinations. You can choose to get either or both.

Q: Will there be a combined COVID and flu shot available for the 2024-2025 season?

A: No, at this time, the COVID-19 and flu vaccines will be given separately. You can sign up for both vaccines.

Q: For the flu shot, will there be two options available, one for the older population and one for the younger population?

A: Yes, you will have the option to sign up for the appropriate vaccine based on your age—pre- or post-65. The choices are indicated on the sign-up form.

Q: If I do not sign up but want a vaccine on the day of the meeting, can I still receive one?

A: You must sign up in advance to **guarantee** that you will receive a vaccine. CVS will have a limited number of extra vaccines, so it may be possible for Trust members who were unable to sign up in advance to receive a vaccine.

Q: What if I can't make it the day of the clinic?

A: It's important that if you sign up for the clinic, that you do show up to get your vaccination. The UAW Retiree Medical Benefits Trust will be charged for unused vaccinations. If your plans change and you cannot attend, please let your local retiree chair or benefit rep (or UAW rep hosting the retiree meeting) know as soon as possible in order to have an accurate headcount.

Q: Do I need to bring anything to the clinic?

A: Yes, you must bring your medical or prescription drug ID card. The vaccine will not be administered without verification of Trust coverage.

Q: On the day of the clinic, what if I cannot find my medical or prescription drug ID card, will CVS be able to obtain member's ID information from the healthcare vendors instead of asking me to pay?

A: Yes, the healthcare vendors can provide insurance information. However, you must be available near the registration station where claims are processed. Please note that the vaccine will not be administered without verification of coverage. No payment of any type will be accepted at the vaccination clinic.

Q: Can I just pay for the vaccine and get reimbursement under the plan, if needed?

A: No. No payment of any type will be accepted at the vaccination clinic.
